UN International Day of Peace at NIS



Thursday, September 21 was the United Nations International Day of Peace! We, at NIS, believe that peace is important and each of us has the global responsibility to promote peace and development. To promote the International Day of Peace, NIS held activities the entire week leading up to the momentous day. On September 14, we launched the Pinwheels for Peace art installation where students designed and made their own pinwheels.
